All it requires is a bit of knowledge, a positive attitude and a good pair of walking shoes.

We'll train you and provide a script. In preparation, you'll shadow an experienced docent on tour as many times as you'd like. As you feel more comfortable and experienced we encourage you to make the tour your own. We promise that we will not ask you to lead a tour until you are comfortable! Your reward is sharing LHR with children while exposing them to art and nature...two very important parts of our East End culture.
